'DIANA' was built by Alvin Beal in the early 1950s on Beals Island, Maine, as a working lobster fishing boat.

In 2002, a new owner asked D. N. Hylan & Assoc. of Sedgewick, Maine to rebuild DIANA for use as a picnic boat for his Downeast summer home. The boats lines were lifted and her original construction documented. A new house and shelter were designed and the original propulsion was changed to a modern Yanmar 110hp. diesel engine. She is beautiful and runs like a fine clock. Diana is traditional carvel plank construction and condition is very good with new topsides and bottom paint.
